Notes

1. ENTRY FEE is £125 per glider. For Cotswold GC full members the fee is £95.00; for juniors or students under 25 the fee is £65.00. A Deposit of £20 is required with this entry form, with the balance due by 30th April. Cheques should be made payable to COTSWOLD GLIDING CLUB.
2. ENTRIES TO THIS COMPETITION ENTERPRISE will be limited to a maximum of 45 visiting gliders, accepted in order of receipt of applications. All applications must be submitted on the form overleaf and be accompanied by the entry fee deposit. The entry fee also covers temporary membership of the Club for all pilots, crew and followers entered overleaf. It is essential that the names of all concerned are entered in Section B. Additional (non-competing) gliders may be brought and flown by competitors or crews on payment of supplementary trailer site fees of £30 per glider incl. VAT, and it will assist our site preparations if the relevant query is answered below. In the event of the Competition being cancelled for any reason whatever, all entry and other fees will be refunded in full.
3. CREDENTIALS - Although not essential at this early stage, it will be helpful if all the detailed particulars requested overleaf in Section A, have been entered. **ENTRANTS ARE REQUESTED TO NOTE THAT THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE THEIR FULL CREDENTIALS, INCLUDING EVIDENCE OF THE APPROPRIATE INSURANCE COVER WITH THIRD PARTY COVER ON ARRIVAL. IT IS, THEREFORE, SUGGESTED THAT THEY BE KEPT READY TO HAND FOR VERIFICATION** - at which time any omission overleaf may be made good.
4. CROSS-CHANNEL TASKS - It may be that you find yourself at the right height over the right spot for a cross-channel (English, not Bristol!) 'long hop', so please bring your passport. We regret not being able to provide cross-channel retrieves.
5. ACCOMMODATION - We have plenty of room for competitors' caravans and tents, plus four twin bunkrooms in the clubhouse. Please indicate your requirements below.
